ANNUAL RESULT

The annual result for the session 2020-21 will be available on the Students Portal on E-Care. Parents are requested to attend the **Online Parent Teacher Meeting**. It is mandatory to attend in order to know the Class & Section and guidelines for the promotion to the next class. The timings will be from 8:00 am to 11:00 am. The Class Teachers will give time slots for each student to attend the PTM.

NEW ACADEMIC SESSION

The new academic session will commence from **5th April 2021** for **Classes Pre Primary to X and XII**. The classes will be held **ONLINE** till the further notification issued by the Government. The Admission details regarding Class XI will be intimated later.

FEE STRUCTURE

Due to unprecedented situation caused during pandemic, the school has faced huge financial challenges in the session 2020-21, but despite the financial shortfalls and budgeting challenges, the School Management has not increased the fees for the **two consecutive years** as we don't want to burden our parents and will provide the best education as a part of our continued endeavor.

We are thankful to all the parents for timely payment of the fee without any reminders as it enables us to function smoothly. Despite financial challenges as there were cases of non-payment of fees by many parents, the School didn't stop any student from attending online classes or to write their exams but we request the parents to clear all the pending dues, if any, before **18th March 2021** to avoid any disciplinary action.

For the academic session 2021-22, parents are required to pay only the Tuition Fee till further notification by the Government. It can be paid either on monthly basis or in installments (of 4 months) as per the table given below:
