3. Observe the trapped dirt remaining on the cloth filter.

1. Smear a thin layer of petroleum jelly (Vaseline) onto a clear plastic sheet.
2. Leave it outside on a windowsill or balcony for 24 hours.

	DRY WASTE	WET WASTE
Meaning	Waste that does not contain moisture.	Waste that is biodegradable and contains moisture.
Examples	Paper, plastic, glass, metal, cardboard, cloth, bottles, cans.	Vegetable peels, fruit peels, leftover food, tea leaves, eggshells, flowers, etc.
Nature	Non-biodegradable (or takes very long to decompose).	Biodegradable (decomposes quickly).
Disposal	Can be recycled or reused.	Can be composted and used as manure.
Bin Color	Blue (or any designated color).	Green (or any designated color).
